Add for compensation for services relative to land in Allegany county, of the estate of Gustavus Scott, of which the agent states, 1000 acres have been secured for the state; 10 per cent. in kind, or an equivalent in money.

And for expenditures on account thereof, in pursuance of resolution No. 15, of 1824.

Resolved, That Resolution No. 60, of December session 1826, be and the same is hereby repealed.

That for final settlement and full satisfaction of all claim or claims, for commission or other compensation, for his services as state's agent for the western shore, which he now has or might have at any time hereafter, the treasurer for the said shore pay to Thomas Kennedy, esquire, formerly the said agent, four hundred and eighty-eight dollars and seventy-five cents current money, and transfer to him, so soon as it may be done, ten per centum of so much of the capital stock of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company as shall be allowed to this state for the debt of the late Potomac Company; and that the authority given to the said agent, as such, by Resolutions No. 15 of December session 1824, be and it is hereby continued to the said Thomas Kennedy, except that from the purchaser or purchasers of the land therein mentioned, he may receive out of the purchase mo-
