The bill reported by Mr. Yoe, on the 16th instant, entitled An act to provide for electing commissioners for Washington county, and prescribing their powers and duties, being entitled to a second reading, was taken up for consideration,

When Mr. Hughlett moved that the said bill be again laid on the table.

And the question thereon being put,
It was determined in the negative.

In the progress of the second reading of said bill,

On motion by Mr. Yoe, the same was amended in its first section, by inserting the words, "after said election," in the 27th line of the section, immediately after the words, "and if any commissioner so elected, shall die, resign, refuse, or neglect, for twenty days."

The said bill having been read throughout and amended,

The question was put, "Shall this bill pass as amended?"

It was resolved in the affirmative, and the bill was sent to the Senate for concurrence.

On motion by Mr. Buskirk, the house proceeded to a second reading, (by a special order obtained for the purpose,) of the bill reported by him yesterday, entitled An act to provide for electing commissioners for Allegany county, and prescribing their powers and duties.
