

Mr. Thomas, of Saint Mary's, (by a special leave of the House, obtained for the purpose,) submitted the following order:

Ordered, That 111 copies of the communication and memorial of the President and Directors of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company be printed, and distributed in the usual manner.

Which was twice read and adopted.

The bill reported by Mr. Nicholas, on the 19th instant, entitled, an act to incorporate the Trustees of St. Charles' College, was taken up for consideration, in just turn. And in the progress of the second reading thereof;

On motion by Mr. Nicholas, the said bill was amended as follows:

In the 2d line of the 2d section, of the printed bill, the word, "corporation," was stricken out, and the word, "trustees" inserted in lieu thereof.

In the 2d line of the 6th section, of the printed bill, a similar amendment was made.

In the 3d line of the 7th section, of the printed bill, the word, "naturalized," was stricken out.

The preamble of the bill was then amended, by striking out so much thereof, as is contained in the following words, viz:

"Whereas, by the Declaration of Rights, all gifts, sales, devises of lands exceeding two acres, to any religious sect, order or denomination, or to any minister of the gospel, preacher, or public teacher, or to, or for the support, use, or benefit of, or in trust for any minister, preacher of the gospel, or public teacher, as such, or any religious order or denomination, and every sale, gift, or devise, of any personal property or monies to persons or bodies, such as aforesaid, is declared to be void, unless the same be given, bequeathed, sold or transferred by leave of the Legislature. And"

The said bill having been read throughout, the question was put, "shall this bill pass, as amended?"

And it was resolved in the affirmative.
