The house proceeded to the consideration of the bill reported by Mr. Jeniser on the 29th ultimo, entitled, an act to alter and amend the twenty-fifth article of the Constitution and Form of Government of this State, so as to electthe Governor for three years instead of one; as at present provided; which had been made the order of the day for Friday last the 5th instant; and it was read the second time.

After some debate thereon.

The question was put, 'shall this bill pass.' And it was determined in the negative.
