

The Clerk of the Senate returned the bills and resolutions of this House, of the following titles:

An act to divorce Ira Emmons and Zilpha Emmons, of Cecil county.

An act to repeal an act, to transfer the Snowhill Militia Company of Worcester county, from the thirty-seventh, to the ninth regiment of Maryland militia, passed at December session, 1828, chapter 41.

An act relating to the records in the Register of Wills office, in Caroline county; and,

An act for the reassessment and revaluation of the real and personal property in Harford county; severally endorsed, 'will pass;' also,

An additional supplement to the act, entitled, an act to amend the Lottery system:

An act supplementary to the act, passed at December session 1826, entitled, an act to prevent Gaming; and,

An act to alter and change the name of Henderson Magruder Williams, according to the will of Henderson Magruder, late of Prince George's county, deceased; severally endorsed, 'will pass with the proposed amendment.'

The amendment to each of said bills was read the first, and, by a special order, the second time, and assented to.

A resolution in favor of Stephen R. Price, of the State of Ohio, who was a soldier of the revolutionary war.

A resolution in favor of Zadock Risten, alias Riston, of Prince Georges's county, who was a soldier of the revolutionary war; and

A resolution authorising the investment in stocks of certain monies therein mentioned; severally endorsed, 'assented to.'

Ordered, That the said bills, with their respective amendments, and the resolutions above mentioned, be severally engrossed.

Also an act to appoint Jane Johnson, of Harford county, trustee for the sale of certain land therein mention, endorsed "will not pass."

Also a resolution in favor of Joshua Burgess, of the state of Kentucky, who was a lieutenant in the army of the revolution

A resolution in favor of Thomas McDowell, of Cecil county, an old revolutionary soldier.

A resolution in favor of Thomas Jenkins, of Prince George's county, who was a soldier of the revolutionary war.
