

Mr. Teackle submitted the following orders:

Ordered, That the members of this house, in respect to the memory of William Done, Esq. deceased, delegate elect, and returned for Somerset county, wear crape on the left arm for thirty days.

Ordered, That the funeral expenses incurred at the Seat of Government, for the interment of William Done, Esq. late a delegate elect to this house, be placed upon the journal of accounts.

On motion by Mr. Tilghman, said orders were entered as unanimously adopted.

On motion by Mr. Hunt,

Ordered, That the rules for the last house of delegates be adopted, as the rules for the government of this house, until they be revised or altered.

On motion of Mr. Teackle, the following order was read and assented to.

Ordered, that the speaker be requested to issue a warrant to the sheriff of Somerset county, for an election to supply the vacancy occasioned by the death of William Done, Esq. a delegate elect and returned for said county.

A warrant of election was accordingly issued, signed by the speaker and clerk, and transmitted by express, to the sheriff of Somerset county.

On motion by Mr. M'Mahon, leave given to bring in a bill, to authorise the clerk of Allegany county to record the deed therein mentioned, and for other purposes: Ordered, That Messrs. M'Mahon, Reed and Shaw, prepare and bring in the same.

On motion by Mr. M'Elfresh, leave given to bring in a bill, to abolish imprisonment for debt in this state. Ordered that Messrs. M'Elfresh, Nicholas and Spence, prepare and bring in the same.

On motion by Mr. Ely, leave given to bring in a bill, to be entitled, An act to abolish all such parts of the Constitution and form of government, as relate to the time and manner of electing the senate, and the mode of filling up vacancies in that body, so that each county and the city of Baltimore may have a senator, to be elected immediately by the people.

Ordered, That Messrs. Ely, Hunt, Kershner, Brookhart, Goldsborough, Hardcastle and Comegys, prepare and bring in the same.

On motion by Mr. Hood,

Ordered, That Messrs. Hood and Brewer, wait on the Rev. Mr. Dorsey, and request his attendance in this house, every morning during the session, to perform divine service.
