That so much thereof as relates to the public revenue, and the state tobacco inspection, be referred to the committee on ways and means.

That so much thereof as relates to the militia, and the pub-

lic arms, be referred to the committee on the militia.

The speaker laid before the house, reports from the clerks of Anne-Arundel and Dorchester counties, relative to the attendance of judges; which were read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice.

Also reports from the clerk of Dorchester county, the sheriff of Washington county, and the Register of the Land Office of the western shore, relative to the several sums of money paid by them into the treasury, within the year ending on the 50th November; which were severally read and referred to the committee on ways and mea.

Also a report from the clerk of Anne-Arundel county, relative to the number of copies of the journal of proceedings remaining in his office; which was read and referred to the committee on the library.

And a report from the trustees of Charlotte Hall school; which was read and referred to the committee on education.

Mr. M'Mahon reports a bill entitled, An act to authorise the clerk of Allegany county to record a deed therein mentioned; which was read the first, and by special order the second time, passed, and sent to the senate.

Mr. Nicholas reports a bill, entitled, An act for the relief

of certain minors therein mentioned.

Mr. Hunt reports a bill, entitled, An act authorising Cornelia A. Howard, guardian of John E. Howard, of the city of Baltimore, to lease certain property therein mentioned.

Mr. Wright reports a bill, entitled, An act to alter and change the names of Levin Wall Hall, his wife Rose Ann Hall, and his daughter Mary Elizabeth Hall, of Dorchester county; And

Mr. Lee reports a bill, entitled, A supplement to the act entitled. An act to allow Adam Robb, executor of Upton Beall, late clerk of Montgomery county court, further time to complete certain records, passed at December session, 1828, chapter 2. Which were severally read.

On motion by Mr. Burchenal, leave given to bring in a bill to extend real estate. Ordered, That Messrs, Burchenal,

Brawner and Hardcastle, report the same,
