Mr. McElfresh presented a petition of Fanny Easterday, of Frederick county, pracing to be divo ced from her husband Jacob Easterday. Also, a petition of Jacob Metzgar, praying to be divorced from his wife Enzabeth Metzgar; which were read, and severally referred to the standing committee on divorces

On motion by Mr. Tilghman, leave given to bring in a bill authorising the treasurer of the western shore o transfer to the credit of the free schools fund the several sums now standing to the credit of the common free schools fund and the county schools fund, and to distribute the same amongst the several counties of this state. Ordered, That Messrs. Tilghman, Merrick, and Thomas of Queen-Anne's, prepare and bring in the same.

On motion by Mr. Edelen, leave given to bring in a bill to be entitled, An act to restrain attorneys or solicitors in chancery from entering their appearance in any suit or action at law or equity in the courts of this state, without social authority. Ordered, That Messrs. Edelen, Brawner and Gantt, report the same.

Mr. Nicholas submitted the following order; which was read and assented to.

Ordered, That the committee on internal improvements be directed to inquire into the expediency of constructing a rail road, at the expense of the state, and with the consent of congress, from the city of Bultimore to the city of W hington; the cost of such a road; the time which its completion would require, and the probable amount of revenue which such a work would yield to the state.
