supply the vacancy which will at that time occur. We therefore propose, with the concurrence of your honourable body, on Thursday the sixth inst. at 12 o'clock, to proceed to the discharge of that duty, agreeably to the constitution of the United States, and the provisions of an act of assembly, passed at November session eighteen hundred and nine, entitled, An act to fix the mode of electing senators to represent this state in the senate of the United States.
