On motion by Mr. Jenifer, the bill reported by Mr. Teackle, entitled, An act supplemental to an act, entitled, An act to promote the preservation, improvement, and increase of shell-fish in this state, and which was made the order of the day for Tuesday the 18th inst. was made the order of the day for Friday next, the 14th inst.

Mr. Jenifer submitted the following resolution, which was read the first and second time by special order, and assented to:

Resolved by the general assembly of Maryland, That the governor and council be, and they are hereby directed to appoint two planters from each of the six most extensive tobacco growing counties in the state, and two shippers of tobacco, who are desired to meet in the city of Baltimore on the third Monday of July next, for the purpose of examining into the condition of the public tobacco-warehouses, and the different scites on the basin, and report to the next legislature their views of the expediency or in expediency of concentrating the inspection of tobacco in the city of Baltimore.

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled, An act to alter and change the name of Levin Wall Hall, his wife, Rose Ann Hall, and his daughter, Mary Elizabeth Hall, of Dorchester county, endorsed, "will pass." Ordered to be engrossed.

And delivered a preamble and resolutions relative to removing the obstructions to the entrance of the harbour of Annapolis; which was read and referred to the committee on internal improvement.

Mr. Blakistone from the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice, delivered the following report:

The committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice to whom was referred a bill, entitled, "An act to authorise the county courts in this state, to enter up judgments in certain cases at the first term," have had the same under consideration, and are of opinion the said bill ought not to pass.
