The house then adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 o'clock.

THURSDAY, January 13, 1831.

The house met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

Mr. Tilghman again appeared in the house.

M. Hunt presented the petition of Isaac West, of the city of Baltimore, praying for a divorce from his wife Fanny West; which was read and referred to the committee on divorces,

Mr. Brookhart presented the memorial of Henry Locher, of Washington county, praying to be remunerated for discoveries made in agriculture, which was read and refer-

red to the standing committee on agriculture.

On motion by Mr. Teackle, leave was given to bring in a bill, entitled, An act to amend the constitution and form of government of this state, in relation to the time of holding elections, and for other purposes. Ordered, That Messrs. Teackle, Gale, McElfresh, Hicks, Brawner, Montgomery and Ely, report the same.

On motion by Mr. Hicks, leave was given to bring in a bill, to be entitled, An act to alter and repeal the act entitled, An act for regulating and inspecting weights and measures used in this state. Ordered, That Messrs. Hicks, Montgomery, Hawkins, Turner and Piner, report the

game.

On motion by Mr. Amos, leave was given to bring in a bill, entitled, A further supplement to an act, entitled, An act for the distribution of a certain tund for the purpose of establishing free schools in the several counties therein mentioned, so far as relates to Harford county. Ordered, That Messrs. Amos, Montgomery and Moores, report the same.

On motion by Mr. Gantt, leave was given to bring in a bill, to be entitled, An act to authorise commissioners to divide Prince-George's county into school districts. Ordered, That Messrs. Gantt, Edelen and Duvall, report the same.
