Mr. Wallis from the select committee to whom was referred the bill from the senate, entitled. An act to fix the compensation of jurors in Kent county, reported that the committee having considered said bill, were of opinion it ought to pass.

The said bills were then severally read.

The bill, entitled, An act for the relief of Mary B. God-win, of the state of Indiana, was read the second time by special order, passed, and sent to the senate.
