The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled, An act concerning the trial of causes in Washington county court. Also the bill, entitled, An act authorising the clerk of Frederick county to record a deed executed by Peter Frick, of the city and county of Baltimore, conveying certain lands therein mentioned to Peter H. Brown, of Frederick county, severally endorsed, "will not pass." And delivered a bill originated in and passed by the senate, entitled, An act to authorise Jonas M'Pherson to lease certain property belonging to the minor children of William Allcock, deceased; which was read and referred to Messrs. Nicholas, Turner and Mackall. Also a bill, entitled, An additional supplement to the act, entitled, An act relating to insolvent debtors in the city and county of Baltimore; which was read and referred to Messrs. Nicholas, Hunt and Ely.

And delivered a communication from the executive department, (received and referred by the senate to the consideration of this house;) which was read and is as follows:
