The house proceeded to consider the bill reported by Mr. Hicks, entitled, An act relating to the manumission of slaves in this state, and for other purposes.

Mr. Ely moved to strike out the enacting clause of the bill.

On the question being put, it was resolved in the affirmative.

On motion by Mr. M'Mahon, The bill reported by him entitled, An act for the preservation and repair of the Cumberland road, was made the order of the day for Monday next the 31st inst.

The bill reported by Mr. Brawner, entitled, An act relating to the manumission of slaves in this state, was taken up for consideration, when on motion by Mr. Hood, said bill was ordered to lie on the table.

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled, An act to prevent bullet playing in and near to Middle-town in Frederick county, endorsed "will pass" Ordered to be engrossed.

Also the bill, entitled, An act to repeal all such parts of the constitution and form of government, as relates to the division of Frederick county into eleven election districts, and for other purposes, endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendment;" which amendment was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.
