Mr. Nicholas presented the memorial of the mayor and city council of Baltimore, relative to certain obstructions to the navigation of the Susquehanna river, erected by authority of the government of Pennsylvania; which was read and referred to the committee already appointed on that subject.

The bill reported by Mr. Merrick, entitled, An act to establish a bank and incorporate a company under the name of The Washington County Bank, at the town of Williamsport, in Washington county, was taken up for consideration.

On motion by Mr. Steele, the 3d section of the bill was amended, by striking out after the word "thereafter," in the 17th line thereof these words, "or until the sum necessary to the incorporation of said company, shall have been subscribed."

The said bill was then read;

When Mr. Steele moved to reconsider the 5th section of the bill for the purpose of amending the same, by striking out after the word "paid," in the 6th line thereof, to the word "when," in the 12th line thereof.

On the question being put, Will the house reconsider the 5th section? it was determined in the negative.

Mr. Teackle moved to postpone said bill indefinitely? Resolved in the affirmative.
