By the *House of Delegates,*

February 1, 1831.

Gentlemen of the Senate,

This being the day fixed by previous arrangement, for the election of bank directors on the part of the state, we propose, with your concurrence, to proceed at one o'clock with said election. The following persons are nominated by this house:

Messrs. Hawkins and Gale are appointed by this house, to join the gentlemen named in your message to examine and count the ballots, and report the result.
