copy of the above resolution to each of our senators and representatives in congress.

Which was read the first, and by special order the second time, and assented to.

The house having proceeded by ballot to the election of directors on the part of the state in the several banks wherein the state, as a stockholder, is entitled to directors, in conformity with arrangement made with the senate for that purpose, and the ballots of the members being collected in the ballot box, it was sealed up and delivered to the committee appointed on the part of this house to meet the committee named on the part of the senate, to count the joint ballot of both houses, and report the result, who retired to the conference room.

On motion by Mr. Hunt, Ordered, That the petition of Ann Matthews, and the documents therewith, be withdrawn from the files of the house.

On motion by Mr. Teackle, Ordered, That the petitions from sundry citizens of several counties in this state, praying for the establishment of a state bank, be withdrawn from the files of the house.

The door-keeper having returned, reported, that in obedience to order he had notified the absent members that their attendance in the house was required.

The house then resumed the consideration of the order of the day.

On motion by Mr. Burchenal, the 1st section of the bill was amended by striking out in the second line thereof the word 'first,' and inserting in lieu thereof 'fifteenth.'

On motion by Mr Burchenal, said section was further amended, by inserting after the word 'next,' in the 2d line thereof, the words 'and in every year thereafter.'

On motion by Mr. Burchenal, the second section of the bill was amended by striking out in the last line thereof the word 'six,' and inserting 'four.'

On motion by Mr. Burchenal, the 3d section of the bill was amended, by inserting after the word each,' in the 7th line thereof, the words 'it shall be the duty of said treasurer.'

The bill was then read the second time and rejected.
