And Mr. Merrick reported a bill, entitled, A supplement to the act, entitled, An act to provide for electing commissioners for Washington county, and prescribing their powers and duties; which said bills were severally read the first, and second time, by special order, passed, and sent to the senate.

On motion by Mr. Hughlett, the house proceeded to consider the message offered by Mr. Merrick on the 2d inst. proposing a continuance of the session until Saturday the 12th inst.

When Mr. Nicholas moved to lay the message on the table.

On the question being put, it was determined in the negative.
