

Mr. M·Kinstrey, reported a bill, entitled, An act to authorise and empower commissioners to open and extend the breadth of an alley in Westminster in Frederick county; which were read.

Mr. Kent, from the committee made a favourable report upon the bill from the senate entitled, An act to authorise the recording of a deed therein mentioned; which was read.

Mr Teackle from the committee on education, reported a bill, entitled, An act to provide for the admission of Allegany county to the benefits of an act, entitled, An act to provide for the public instruction of youth in primary schools throughout this state.

Mr. Hicks reported a bill, entitled, A supplement to an act, entitled, An act to incorporate the New-Market Academy, in Dorchester county, passed at December session 1829, chapter 173.

Mr. Burchenal reported a bill, entitled, An act to lay out and bound the limits of the village of Greensborough, in Caroline county.

And Mr. Gantt reported a bill, entitled, A supplement to the act, entitled, An act to build or repair the jail of Prince-George's county.

Which were severally read the first and second time by special order, passed, and sent to the senate.

The bill, entitled, A supplement to the act, entitled, An act to enable the purchasers to obtain possession of lands and premises sold by sheriffs, coroners and elisors, at public auction, passed December session 1825, chapter 103; and

The bill, entitled, An act for the relief of Susanna Holmes, of Baltimore county, were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time, passed, and sent to the senate.

The resolution in favour of Joseph Wicks the 4th, (late state's agent,) was taken up for consideration, read the second time, passed, and sent to the senate.

On motion by Mr. Chapman, the amendments proposed by the senate to the bill, entitled, An act for the benefit of Horatio Claggett, of Alexandria, were read the second time, assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

On motion by Mr. Tilghman, the house took up for consideration the bill, entitled, An act to extend the powers of the commissioners of the school fund in Queen-Anne's county, and to encourage the establishment of free schools in said county.
