Mr. Laurenson presented the memorial of William W. Taylor and others, relative to a street in the city of Baltimore; which was read and referred to Messrs. Laurenson, Hunt and Stansbury.

And, Mr. Brookhart presented the petition of Maria A. Ringgold, of Washington county, praying the repeal of so much of the act passed at December session, 1830, as requires other security than the bonds of the commissioners themselves, for the sale of a tract of land in which the petitioner and her children are interested; which was read and referred to Messrs. Brookhart, Hall and Hollman.

The Speaker laid before the House reports from the clerks of Prince George's, Talbot and Cecil counties, relative to the attendance of Judges; which were read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice.

Also a report from the clerk of Talbot county court, relative to the several sums of money paid by him into the Eastern Shore Treasury within the year, ending on the 30th of November, 1831.

Also, a communication from the cashier of the Mechanics' Bank of Baltimore, containing a statement of the affairs of said Bank; which were read and severally referred to the committee on ways and means.

And a report from the clerk of the commissioners of Calvert county, in relation to the levy of said county; which was read and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Brown, of Queen Anne's, obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, An act regulating joint fences in Queen Anne's county; ordered, That Messrs. Brown, of Queen Anne's, Carmichael and Roberts report the same.

Mr. Moores obtained leave to bring in a bill, to be entitled a supplement to the act, entitled, An act for regulating and inspecting weights and measures used in this State, so far as relates to Harford county; ordered, That Messrs. Moores, Gantt and Heard report the same.

Mr. Heard obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled An act to authorise the levy court of Saint Mary's county, to levy a sum of money to build a court house in said county; ordered, That Messrs. Heard, Blakistone and Sothoron report the same.

Mr. Moores obtained leave to bring in a bill, to be entitled An act relating to the crier of Harford county court; ordered, That Messrs. Moores, Amos and Sutton report the same.
