Mr. Moores reported a bill, entitled, A supplement to the act, entitled, An act for electing commissioners for Hartford county, and prescribing their powers and duties passed at December session, 1827.

And, Mr. Hardcastle reported a bill, entitled, An act to erect a new bridge over Great Choptank River, at Greensborough, in Caroline county.

Which were severally read.

The bill reported by Mr. Brookhart, entitled, A supplement to An act, entitled, An act for the benefit of M. A. Ringgold and children, was taken up for consideration, read the second time, passed, and sent to the Senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Thomas, of Queen Anne's, entitled, An act for the revaluation of the real and personal property in Queen Anne's county, was taken up for consideration.

When, on motion by Mr. Brown, of Queen Anne's, said bill was ordered to lie on the table.

On motion by Mr. Johnson,

Ordered, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore, report to this house, the aggregate amount of revenue of each county, and the city of Baltimore, paid into the Treasury of this State, for the year ending on the 30th of November, 1831.

The House then adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 o'clock.

TUESDAY, January 10th 1832.

The House met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.
