On motion by Mr. Teackle, said bill was further amend-

ed, by adding the following as an additional section.

"And be it enacted, That this act shall continue in force until the year eighteen hundred and fifty-two, and until the end of the next succeeding session of the General Assembly."

The said bill was then read the second time as amended,

and passed.
