and he is hereby authorised and required, to issue to Richard Coe, of Prince George's county, a soldier of the revolution, a common warrant for fifty acres of vacant land, lying to the westward of Fort Cumberland, in Allegany county, and to issue a patent for the said quantity of acres of land, upon a certificate of the survey thereof, duly returned, without requiring payment, or proof of payment, of any composition money therefor;

Which was read.

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled, An act to make valid and confirm the proceedings of Job Allen, as a justice of the peace for Somerset county, endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendments;" which amendments were severally read the first and second time by special order, assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed;

And delivered the following message:—
