Provided, That no branch shall be established in any state, other than that in which the principal bank is established, without the consent of the legislature of such state, and in that event, to be subject to a rate of taxation, upon the amount of its loans or discounts, or the amount of capital employed therein, at the election of the legislature, not exceeding the average of assessments upon real and personal property thereof.
