And the resolutions from the senate, relative to re-chartering the United States Bank, were sent to the senate.

Mr. Sutton presented the petition of Philip Sager of Harford county, praying to be placed on the pension list of said county; which was read and referred to the committee on pensions to indigent persons by county assessment.

Mr. Carmichael presented the petition of John Cummins, of the state of Delaware, praying the passage of an act to enable him to remove a negro out of this state, in whom he possesses an unexpired term; which was read and referred to Messrs. Carmichael, Thomas, of Queen Anne's and Roberts.

Mr. Holmes presented the petition of William Houch, of Baltimore county, praying the passage of an act to authorize him to collect certain monies therein mentioned; which was read and referred to Messrs. Holmes, Turner, of Bal-

timore, and Ely.

Mr. Cottman presented the memorial of Robert J. H. Henry and others, of Somerset county, praying the attenion of the legislature to the subject of the coloured population of this state; which was read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice;

And Mr. Laurenson presented the petition of Sheppard C. Leakin and others, praying for an act to open and extend Pleasant street, in the city of Baltimore; which was read and referred to Messrs. Laurenson, Hunt and Turner,

of Baltimore.
