The bill reported by Mr. Hunt, entitled, An act for the shutting up of a certain part of Forrest street extended, in the city of Baltimore;

Also, the bill reported by him, entitled, A supplement to an act, entitled, An act for the widening of certain streets near the Washington Monument, in the city of Baltimore, and for other purposes therein mentioned;

And the bill, entitled, An act to blend New Town, Trap, and New Freedom, in Frederick county, into one by the name of Jefferson, and to establish boundaries of lots by commissioners and to incorporate the same;

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time, and passed.

The unfavourable report of the committee on claims, upon the petition of Joshua Guyton, Sheriff of Harford county, was taken up for consideration.

When Mr. Moores offered as a substitute for the report the following resolution.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the Western Shore, be, and he is hereby authorised and required to pay Joshua Guyton, Sheriff of Harford county, or his order the sum of two hundred and twenty-five dollars being the amount advertised and expended by said Guyton, for the apprehension of negro Nace, who escaped from the jail of Harford county, in September last. Provided always, that before the payment of the said sum of money, the said Guyton shall produce to the treasurer a receipt, shewing that he had duly paid the said sum, with his own affidavit thereto annexed.
