Which was read.

Mr. Turner, of Baltimore, moved that said report have a second reading by special order,

Determined in the negative.

Mr. Lyles, chairman of the committee on inspections, made unfavorable reports on the petition of Henry Webb and others, of the city of Baltimore, praying an alteration in the mode of inspecting shad;

Also the petition of C. A. Karthaus and others, of the city of Baltimore, praying the passage of an act to limit the dimensions of tobacco hogsheads,

Which were severally read.

Mr. Heard reported a bill, entitled, An act for the relief of Joseph Stone and others, securities for William Williams, late Sheriff and collector of Saint Mary's county.

Which was read the first, and second time, by special order; passed and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Turner, of Baltimore, reported a bill, entitled, An act to authorise the commissioners of Baltimore county to appoint collectors in the cases therein mentioned.

And, Mr. Stansbury reported a bill, entitled, An act to authorise and empower the commissioners of Baltimore county, to levy a sum of money and rebuild a bridge over Herring Run, on the road leading from Baltimore to Belle Air, on what is called the Belle Air road.

Which were severally read.

Mr. Cottman reported a bill, entitled, An act to provide for the erection of a building for the accommodation of Somerset county court.

Which was read the first, and second time by special order; passed, and sent to the Senate.

The clerk of the Senate returned the bill, entitled, A supplement to the act, entitled, An act to establish a Bank and incorporate a company under the name of the Frederick County Bank;

Also, the bill, entitled, An act to incorporate the Carmelite Sisters of Baltimore;

Also, the bill, entitled, An act for the shutting up of a certain part of Forrest street extended, in the city of Baltimore;

Also, the bill, entitled, An act to lay out and open a road in Montgomery and Frederick counties;
