And, the bill, entitled, An act to provide for building a bridge over the Patapsco Falls, at or near the Thisle Factory, severally endorsed, "will pass;" ordered to be engrossed;

Also the bill entitled, An act to authorise the clerk of Dorchester county court, to record a deed from Hugh

Neild, and James Neild, to William Dorsey;

Also, the bill, entitled, An act to authorise the clerk of Harford county court, to record the deeds therein men-

tioned,

And, the bill, entitled, An act to alter and change the location of part of the second and third election districts in Dorchester county, severally endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendments;" which amendments were severally read the first, and second time by special order; severally assented to; and the bills ordered to be engrossed;

Also, the resolution in favour of John J. Jacob;

Also, the resolution authorising the Governor and Coun-

cil o settle the account of Joseph N. Lewis;

And, the resolution requiring the treasurer of the Western Shore, to pay to his Excellency the Governor, or to his order, a certain sum of money therein mentioned, severally endorsed, "assented to;" and ordered to be engrossed;

And, delivered a bill, originated in and passed by the Senate, entitled, A further supplement to an act, entitled, An act to authorise the Governor and Council of Maryland, to appoin the inspectors of flour for this state, passed at December session, 1825, chapter 174; which was read, and referred to the committee on inspections.

The resolutions authorising the Governor and Council to forward annually, to the Executive of each state and territory in the Union, three copies of the laws annually passed by the General Assembly of this state, &c. were taken up for consideration read the second time, and assented to.

The bill from the Senute, entitled, A further supplement to the act, entitled, An act to incorporate the Baltimore and Pitston Coal Company, was taken up for consideration.

When, on motion by Mr. Ely, the first section of the bill was amended, by inserting after the word "Baltimore," in the second line thereof, the words "and Pitston."

The said bill was then read the second time, and passed,

with the proposed amendment.

The clerk of the Senate delivered a bill, originated in and passed by the Senate, entitled, An act supplementary to an act, passed at December session, in the year eighteen hundred and twenty seven, chapter one hundred and eighty
