

Also, reported a bill, entitled, An act relating to a certain road in Baltimore county, therein mentioned;

And, Mr. Ely reported a bill, entitled, An act to incorporate the Baltimore and Chesapeake Steam Saw Mill company;

Which were severally read.

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled, An act to authorise the commissioners of Washington county, to raise a sum of money for the purpose therein mentioned;

Also the bill, entitled, An act to authorise the mayor and city council of Baltimore, to alter the grade of Calvert street in said city;

Also the bill, entitled, An act to amend the constitution and form of government, as it relates to the division of Somerset county into election districts;

And the bill, entitled, A supplement to an act, entitled, An act for the widening of certain streets near the Washington Monument, in the city of Baltimore, and for other purposes therein mentioned; severally endorsed "will pass," ordered to be engrossed;

Also the bill, entitled, An act for the re-valuation and re-assessment of the real and personal property in Worcester county; endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendment," which amendment was twice read, assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed;

And the bill, entitled, An act relating to the jail of Baltimore city and county; endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendments," which amendments were severally read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Edelen, chairman of the committee on lotteries, entitled, An additional supplement to the act to amend the lottery system, was taken up for consideration;

When on motion by Mr. Edelen, said bill was amended by adding at the end thereof as an additional section, the following

And be it enacted, that one at least of said commissioners shall reside in the city of Baltimore, and in lieu of the salary heretofore given to said commissioners—the commissioner or commissioners residing in the said city, shall hereafter be entitled to receive at the rate of ten per centum, and the said commissioners residing in the country, at the rate of seven and a half per centum each, upon the amount raised by the lottery system.
