

Provided, that the compensation to the commissioner or commissioners residing in the said city, shall in no event exceed the sum of \$2,000 each, in any one year, and the compensation to the commissioners in the country, in no event to exceed the sum of \$1500 each in any one year.

The said bill was then read the second time as amended, passed and sent to the senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Hollman, entitled, An act to establish a Bank and incorporate a company, under the name of the Washington County Bank, at the town of Williamsport, in Washington county, was taken up for consideration;

When on motion by Mr. Fitzhugh, said bill was amended by adding at the end thereof the following proviso:

Provided, that if no company to make said road, be incorporated within the time limited for said subscription, then the said subscription shall be made as soon afterwards as a company to make such road shall be incorporated and organised. Or in the stock of the Boonsborough Turnpike Company. Or in the stock of the turnpike road from Cavetown Washington county, to Westminster in Frederick county.

The said bill was then read the second time as amended, passed and sent to the senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Heard, entitled, An act for the benefit and relief of St. Mary's county, and all persons concerned in the records thereof lately burned, was taken up for consideration, read the second time, passed, and sent to the senate.

On motion by Mr. Sothoron,

The house took up for consideration the bill reported by him, entitled, A further supplement to the act, entitled, An act for marking and bounding land; passed at November session 1786, as relates to St. Mary's county.

On motion by Mr. Sothoron,

The second section of said bill was amended, by inserting after the word "commission" in the second line thereof, these words "on or before the first day of April next, and annually thereafter."

The said bill was then read the second time as amended, and passed.
