The bill reported by Mr. Laurenson, entitled, An act for the incorporation of the Grand Lodge of the state of Maryland of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows. was taken up for consideration.

On motion by Mr. Teackle, said bill was amended by striking out in the first section and forty-second line, the word "twenty," and inserting in lieu thereof, the word "ten."

On motion by Mr. Pearce, said section was further amended by adding at the end thereof the following, in these words, "and shall not engage in any operations of trade or merchandizing."

Mr. Moores moved to strike out the fourth section of the bill;

On motion by Mr. Teackle, the fourth section of said bill was amended, by adding at the end thereof, these words, "for city purposes."

On motion by Mr. Teackie, said bill was further amended, by adding at the end thereof as an additional section, the following;

"And be it enacted, That this act shall continue in force until the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-five, and until the end of the next general assembly which shall happen thereafter, and no longer.
