The bill reported by Mr. Purnell, entitled, An act authorising the levy court of Worcester county, to levy on the assessable property of said county, a sum of money, for the purposes therein mentioned; was taken up for consideration, read the second time and passed.

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled, A further supplement to the act, to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from near Ellicott's lower mills towards George Town, in the District of Columbia; endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendments," which amendments were severally read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table;

And delivered a bill originated in and passed by the senate, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, An act relating to certain books and records in the orphans' court of Baltimore county; passed at December session, 1830, chapter 70; which was read and referred to Messrs. Laurensen, Holmes, and Turner of Baltimore county.
