

The bill reported by Mr. Lyles, chairman of the committee on inspections, entitled, An act supplementary to an act, entitled, an act authorising the governor and council of this state, to appoint inspectors of salt fish, for the city of Baltimore; and for other purposes; passed at December session, 1826, chapter 137; was taken up for consideration; when,

On motion by Mr. Laurensou, said bill was ordered to lie on the table.

On motion by Mr. Holmes, the house took up for consideration the bill, reported by him, entitled, An act to extend the jurisdiction of justices of the peace;

On motion by Mr. Holmes, said bill was amended, by inserting in the first section, twelfth line, after the word 'apply,' these words, 'in cases over fifty dollars, and not exceeding one hundred;'

The said bill was then read the second time, as amended, and passed.

The bill reported by Mr. Jones, of Frederick, entitled, An act authorising the levy court of Frederick county, at their discretion, to levy a sum of money to erect a bridge over Linganore creek;

The bill reported by Mr. Johnson, entitled, An act to incorporate Mechanic's Town, in Frederick county;

The bill reported by Mr. Heard, entitled, An act to authorise the register of wills of Saint Mary's county, to record certain papers destroyed by fire; and for other purposes;

And, the bill reported by Mr. Jones, of Frederick, entitled, An act to authorise the levy court of Frederick county, at their discretion, to levy a sum of money, to erect a bridge over Bush creek, in said county;

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time, and passed.

The bill reported by Mr. Wilson, of Cecil, entitled, An act to repeal an act, and its supplements therein mentioned; was taken up for consideration; when,

On motion by Mr. Thomas, of Cecil, said bill was ordered to lie on the table.

The clerk of the Senate, returned the bill, entitled, An act to continue in force the acts of Assembly, which would expire with the present session;

Also, the bill, entitled, A supplement to the act, entitled, An act to provide for electing commissioners for Allegany county, and prescribing their powers and duties; passed December session, 1829, chapter 25;
