The house met. Present the same members as on yester-day. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

Also the bill, entitled, An act to authorise the levy court of Frederick county, at their discretion, to levy a sum of money to erect a bridge over Bush creek in said county;

Also the bill, entitled, An act for the incorporation of the Grand Lodge of the state of Maryland of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows;

Also the bill, entitled, An act to extend the jurisdiction

of justices of the peace;

And the bill, entitled, An act to incorporate the Maryland Beneficial Society of Baltimore;

Were sent to the senate.
