

TUESDAY, February 7th, 1832.

The house met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

Mr. Rasin, who has been confined by indisposition, again appeared in the house and resumed his seat.

The bill, entitled, An act to incorporate Baer's Chemical Works of Baltimore;

Also the bill, entitled, An act authorising the levy court of Worcester county, to levy on the assessable property of said county, a sum of money for the purposes therein mentioned;

Also the bill, entitled, An act to incorporate the Baltimore and Annapolis Rail Road Company;

Also the bill, entitled, An act authorising the levy court of Frederick county, at their discretion, to levy a sum of money to erect a bridge over Linganore creek;

Also the bill, entitled, An act to incorporate Mechanics' Town in Frederick county;

Also the bill, entitled, An act to authorise the register of wills of St. Mary's county, to record certain papers destroyed by fire, and for other purposes;

Also the bill, entitled, An act to authorise the levy court of Frederick county, at their discretion, to levy a sum of money to erect a bridge over Bush creek in said county;

Also the bill, entitled, An act for the incorporation of the Grand Lodge of the state of Maryland of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows;

Also the bill, entitled, An act to extend the jurisdiction of justices of the peace;

And the bill, entitled, An act to incorporate the Maryland Beneficial Society of Baltimore;

Were sent to the senate.

Mr. M'Kinstrey presented the petition of sundry inhabitants of Frederick county, praying for a further supplement to an act, passed at December session 1828, chapter 89, authorising the appointment of commissioners for the purposes therein mentioned; which was read and referred to Messrs. M'Kinstrey, Richardson and Jones, of Frederick.

Mr. Johnson presented the petition of Joseph Talbott, of Frederick county, praying that a certain sum of money may be refunded him.

Mr. Moores presented the petition of John Kean, former sheriff of Harford county, praying the state to refund him a certain sum of money therein mentioned;
