Mr. Roberts reported a bill, entitled, An act directing the entry of satisfaction of judgments decrees and recognizances, and of payments on executions.

Mr. Richardson reported a bill, entitled, A further supplement to the act, entitled, An act to incorporate Freder-

icktown, in Frederick county;

Also, reported a bill, entitled, An act to authorise the executors of the last will and testament of William N. Ritchic, deceased, to bring into the state of Maryland certain slaves.

Mr. Holmes reported a bill, entitled, An act to provide for the building a bridge over the Great Falls of Gunpowder, at or near to Jessop's Mill, in Baltimore county.

Mr. Lantz reported a bill, entitled, An act for the relief

of Margaret Saylor of Allegany county;

And, Mr. Hunt from the committee on Internal Improvement, reported a bill, entitled, An act to incorporate the Millington and Smyrna Rail Road Company.

Which were severally read.

Mr. Hunt from the committee, to which was referred the bill from the Senate, entitled, An act supplementary to the act, entitled, An act to establish a House of Refuge for juvenile delinquents; reported, that he had been instructed by the majority of said committee to report the same without amendment; which was read, and on motion by Mr. Hunt made the order of the day for Wednesday next, the 15th instant.

Mr. Hunt from the committee, also made a favourable report upon the bill from the Senate, entitled, An act supplementary to an act, passed at December session, in the year 1827, chapter 183, entitled A further supplement to the act, entitled, An act to erect Baltimoretown, in Baltimore county into a city, and to incorporate the inhabitants thereof.
