report upon the bill from the Senate, entitled A supplement to an act, entitled, An act relating to certain books and records in the orphans' court of Baltimore county, passed at December session 1830, chapter 70.

Which was read.

The said bill was then read the first, and second time by special order, passed and returned to the Senate.

On motion by Mr. Nicols the house took up for consideration the bill reported by him, entitled, An act to authorise Samuel Pattison, collector and administrator of Nathaniel Applegar h, late Sheriff of Dorchester county, to complete his collections.

The said bill was then read the second time by special order, passed and sent to the Senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Teackle, entitled, An act to enlarge the Dublin Election district, in Somerset county, was taken up for consideration, read the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Lyles, chairman of the committee on inspections, entitled, An act supplementary to an act, entitled, An act authorising the Governor and Council of this State, to appoint inspectors of salt fish, for the city of Baltimore, and for other purposes, passed at December session, 1826, chapter 137, was taken up for consideration, and read the second time.

Mr. Orrell moved to recommit the bill.

Determined in the negative.

The question was then put, shall the said bill pass.

Determined in the negative. On motion by Mr. Heard,

Ordered, That the committee on inspections be instructed to inquire into the expediency of reducing the price of the inspection of salted fish in the city of Baltimore, and to report by bill or otherwis.

The bill reported by Mr. Fitzhugh, entitled, An act to alter and repeal all such parts of the constitution, and form of government of this state, as relate to the division of Washington county into election districts, was taken up for consideration.

On motion by Mr. Hollman, said bill was recommitted.

On motion by Mr. Stockett, the amendments proposed by the Senate to the bill, entitled, A further supplement to the act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from near Eliicott's Lower Mills, towards Georgetown, in the District of Columbia, were taken up for consideration,
