the committee on divorces.

Mr. White presented the petition of Rebecca Mollison, of Montgomery county, praying to be placed on the pension list of said county; which was read and referred to the committee on pensions to indigent persons by county assessment;

Mr. Carmichael presented the petition of Ann Kennard, of Queen Anne's county, praying the passage of an act for

her; benefit;

Also, presented the petition of John A. Sangston and Mary S. Gibson, executors of Elizabeth Maxwell, deceased, praying the passage of an act relative to a negro therein mentioned;

Which were severally read and referred to the committee

on grievances and courts of justice.

Mr. Carmichael also presented the petition of John A. Sangston, Mary S. Gibson and Pere Wilmer, of Queen Anne's county, praying the passage of an act to authorise the sale of the real estate of Mark Benton, deceased;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Carmichael, Brown, of Queen Anne's and Thomas, of Queen Anne's.

Mr. Wright obtained Teave to bring in a bill, to be entitled, An act relating to coroners; ordered, that Messrs. Wright, Willson, of Montgomery, and Ely, report the same.

Mr. M'Kinstrey obtained leave to bring in a bill to repeal all such parts of the constitution and form of government as relates to the division of Frederick county, into twelve election districts, and for other purposes; ordered, that Messrs. M'Kinstrey, Richardson and Johnson report the same.
