

Mr. Stewart reported a bill, entitled, An act to authorise a toll to be collected upon the bridge in the city of Baltimore, over the mouth of Gwynn's Falls, for the repairs thereof.

Mr. Wright reported a bill, entitled, An act relating to coroners;

And, Mr. Brookhart reported a bill, entitled, An act to authorise the clerk of Washington county court, to record the deed therein mentioned;

Which were severally read.

The bill reported by Mr. Teachell, entitled, A supplement to an act, to incorporate the Baltimore Life Insurance Company; was taken up for consideration, read the second time and passed.

On motion by Mr. Johnson,

The house took up for consideration the bill reported by him, entitled, An act relating to a part of a lot of ground in Frederick county;

On motion by Mr. Johnson,

Said bill was amended by adding at the end thereof the following—

“And if upon investigation the said commissioners or a majority of them, shall be of opinion that the said Birely is legally entitled to the said land, then the treasurer of the Western Shore shall pay to the said commissioners the necessary charges as before designated.”

The said bill was then read the second time, as amended, and passed.

Mr. Laurenson submitted the following message—
