Also, the bill, entitled, An additional supplement to the act, entitled, An act to provide for the repairs of public roads in Montgomery county, passed at December session, 1826, chapter 227;

Severally endorsed, 'will pass;' ordered to be engrossed. Also, the bill, entitled, An act for the benefit of William Houch, of Baltimore county; endorsed, will pass with the

proposed amendment;

Which a pendinent was read the first and second time by special order; assented to; and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

And, delivered a bill, originated in and passed by the senate entitled, An act to incorporate the Mechanics Institute and Frederick Lyceum; which was read and referred to

Messrs. Mckinstrey, Richardson, and Johnson.

Mr. Brown, of Queen Anne's, from the committee to which was referred the bill from the senate, entitled, An act to alter the time of the meeting of the General Assembly of this State, and for other purposes; reported the same, with the following amendment:

Amendment Proposed.

In the 4th section, first line, after the word 'part,' insert the words 'or parts;'

Which was read.

On motion by Mr. Wilson, of Cecil, the house took up for consideration the bill reported by him, entitled, An act to repeal an act, and its supplements therein mentioned;

Mr. Thomas, of Cecil, moved to lay the bill on the table, and make it the order of the day for Thursday next, the

16th inst.;

Determined in the negative.

On motion by Mr. Ely, the house was called, and the door keeper sent for the absent members. Before his return The house adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 o'clock.
