WEDNESDAY, February 15th, 1832.

The house met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The bill, entitled, An act for the relief of George Baltzell collector of taxes for Frederick county;

Also the bill, entitled, An act to regulate the weight of Quercitron and all other ground bark, Sumach, and other articles sold by weight in this state;

Also the bill, entitled, An act for the re-valuation of real and personal property in Talbot county;

Also the bill, entitled, A supplement to an act, entitled, An act to provide for the purchase of the office papers belonging to the surveyor's office of Frederick county, and to repeal an act therein mentioned;

Also the bill, entitled, An act to authorise the clerk of Washington county court to record the deed therein mentioned;

Also the bill, entitled, An act to repeal all such parts of the constitution and form of government as relate to the division of Frederick county, into twelve election districts and for other purposes;

Also the bill, entitled, A supplement to the act, entitled, An act to incorporate companies to make several turnpike roads through Baltimore county, and for other purposes, passed on the 12th day of January 1805, chapter 51;

And the bill, entitled, An act for the relief of James Williams, Jr. of the city of Baltimore;

Were sent to the senate.
