the convenience of farmers through whose lands said canal

may pass, and for other purposes.

Mr. Armstrong presented the petition of sundry citizens of Allegany county, praying certain restrictions may be imposed on the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company;

Which were severally read, and referred to the commit-

tee on internal improvement.

Mr. Hall presented the petition of Casper Moudy of Washington county, praying to be placed on the pension list of said county; which was read and referred to the committee on pensions to indigent persons by county assessment.

Mr. Wilson, of Cecil, presented the petition of sundry citizens of Cecil county, praying that the commissioners of said county, be directed to levy a sum of money to pay for the building a bridge over the Big Eik River, in the town of Elkton, and to raise the road leading from said bridge southward above tide water; which was read and referred to Messrs. Wilson, of Cecil, Cameron and Thomas, of Cecil.

Mr. Ely presented the petition of sundry citizens of Baltimore and Anne Arundel counties, praying the repeal of the second and third sections of an act, entitled, A second supplement to the act, entitled, An act to incorporate the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company, passed at December session 1830, chapter 117; which was read and referred to the committee already appointed on that subject.

Mr. M'Kinstrey presented the petition of sundry citizens of Frederick county, praying for the redress of certain grievances therein mentioned; which was read and referred

to the committee on grievances and courts of justice;

And Mr. Laurenson presented the memorial of Alexanper Smyth, and other citizens of the city of Baltimore; on the subject of the militia; which was read and referred to the committee on the militia

Mr. Stockett obtained leave to bring in a bill, to be entitled, An act for the relief of Richard Iglohart, late sheriff of Anne Arundel county; ordered, that Messrs. Stockett,

Kent and Hood, report the same.

Mr. Lantz obtained leave to bring in a bill, authorising the commissioners of Allegany county, to appoint three decreet persons at their next meeting, to change and alter the location of the road from Old Town in said county to Cumberland, or where they may think it expedient and proper; ordered, that Messrs. Lantz, Armstrong and Blair, report
