Mr. Kent, chairman of the committee on education, reported a bill, entitled, A further supplement to the act, entitled, An act for the benefit of the trustees of Garrison Forest Academy, and the Franklin Academy, in Baltimore county.

Mr. Turner from the committee on divorces reported a bill, entitled, An act to divorce, Mary Besore, of Frederick county, from her husband Jacob Besore.

Mr. Stockett reported a bill, entitled, An act for the benefit of Richard Iglehart, late Sheriff of Anne Arundel county.

Mr. Johns reported a bill, entitled, An act authorising and empowering the commissioners of Harford county to levy a sum of money on the assessable property of said county for purposes therein mentioned.

Mr. Carmichael reported a bill, entitled, An act to direct the court of Queen Anne's county to authorise the sale of the real estate of Mark Beaton, deceased.

Mr. Stockett reported a bill, entitled, An act supplementary to the acts relating to the University of Maryland;

And, Mr. Carmichael reported a bill entitled, An act for the protection of oysters, in the waters of the eastern shore of this state; which were severally read;

Mr. Hunt, from the committee, made a favourable report upon the bill from the senate, entitled, An act to incorporate the United States Insurance company of Baltimore; which was read.

On motion by Mr. Roberts,

Mr. Johnson was appointed on the committee, to which was recommitted the bill, entitled, An act directing the entry of satisfaction of judgments, decrees and recognizances, and of payments on executions, to supply the vacancy occasioned by the indisposition of Mr. Edelen, and said committee was also enlarged by adding thereto Messrs. Brown, of Queen Anne's, and Ely.

On motion by Mr. Wilson, of Cecil, seconded by two other members who voted in the majority, the house reconsidered their vote upon the bill from the senate, entitled, An act supplementary to an act passed at December session, 1831, entitled, An act to authorise the rebuilding of a bridge over Conowingo creek, at or near Abijah Fenns, in Cecil county.
