On motion by Mr. Teackle,

Said résolution was further amended, by inserting after the word "banks," in the sixth line, the words "or Savings Institution."

On motion by Mr. Teackle,

Said resolution was further amended, by inserting in the seventh line thereof, after the words "shall," these words, "give an assurance or guaranty satisfactory to the treasurer and;"

The said resolution was then read the second time as

amended;

When on motion by Mr. Brawner,

Said resolution was laid on the table, and made the order

of the day for Thursday next the 23d inst.

The house then proceeded to consider the second order of the day, being the bill reported by Mr. Johnson, entitled, An additional supplement to the act, entitled, An act for the promotion of internal improvement.

Mr. Brookhart moved to amend said bill, by inserting after the word "counties" in the first section sixth line, the

following,

Provided always, the said company shall not locate and lay their said rail road along the valley of the Potomac river, further than western Harper's Ferry.

Determined in the negative. On motion by Mr. Johnson,

Said bill was amended by striking out in the first section, twentieth line, the word "travelling;" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "transportation."

Mr. Brookhart, moved further to amend said bill by ad-

ding at the end thereof, the following proviso.

Provided also, that the said President and Directors of the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company, shall within six months after the passage of this act, elect and determine whether or not they will locate and lay their said Rail-road in and through Washington and Allegany counties.

Determined in the negative.

Mr. Hollman, moved to amend said bill by adding at the end thereof the following proviso.

Provided, the Governor and Council of Maryland be authorised and required to appoint one or more Engineers and State Commissioners, of which one at least shall reside in Washington county, to examine and explore that part of Frederick, Washington and Allegany counties, to excertain
