whether it is not practicable to locate a route to make a Rail Road through the counties above mentioned, and report to the Governor and Council, on or before the first day of October next. The costs of survey and examination to be at the expense of the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company.

Determined in the negative.

The said bill was then read the second time, and passed. On motion by Mr. Hollman, the yeas and nays were ordered, and appeared as follows.
