

by adding at the end thereof the following, as an additional section.

*And be it enacted,* That no part of this act shall take effect in the said county, unless it be approved by a majority of the voters of the said county, and that for the purpose of testing the opinions of the said voters, on the question whether they will prefer a district system as is provided in this act, or a system by general ticket, for electing commissioners in the said county, it shall be the duty of the judges of election at the next election for Delegates to receive the votes of the said people, on the said question and report the result to the next General Assembly.

Determined in the negative.
