Which was read the first and second time by special order and assented to.

Mr. Rogerson chairman of the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims, made favorable reports upon the petition of Catharine Grove, of Washington county, and the orders of the house, to enquire into the expediency of allowing a pension to Elizabeth Donnelly and Patience Fairbrother, (widows of revolutionary soldiers,) accompanied with the following resolutions;
