funds and means which may come to their hands by virtue of this act, which may have been contributed by way of donation to erect a House of Industry in Baltimore, before the passage of the act, entitled, "An act to authorise the Lottery therein mentioned," passed at December session, eighteen hundred and fourteen, chapter one hundred and sixteen; provided, that such sums be demanded by said contributors, or their representatives aforesaid, respectively within six months after the passage of this act."

On motion by Mr. Bell, said section was further amend-

ed, by adding at the end thereof the following.

"Of which public notice shall be given in one or more newspapers printed in the city of Baltimore, for the space of two weeks."

On motion by Mr. Handy, said section was further

amended, by adding at the end thereof the following.

"And provided also, that the juvenile delinquents that may be sent to the House of Refuge, from the respective counties in the State of Maryland, shall be supported at the expense of the said House of Refuge, and not of the several counties from wnich they may be sent, any thing in the original act to which this is a supplement to the contrary thereof notwithstanding?

Mr. Ely moved to amend said bill by striking out from the word, "Baltimore," in the second line, to the word "be,"

in the third line thereof.

Determined in the negative.

On motion by Mr. Handy, said bill was amended by adding at the end of the fourth section of said bill, the following, "after the payment of the debt due thereon."

The said bill was then read the second time as amended.

On the question being put, shall the said bill pass.

It was determined in the negative.

The clerk of the senate returned the bill entitled, an act to establish a bank and incorporate a company under the name of the Washington County Bank, at the town of

Williamsport in Washington county;

Also, the bill entitled, An act to incorporate the Peoples' Steam Navigation Company; severally endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendments;" which amendments were severally read the first and second time by special order, severally assented to, and the bills ordered to be engrossed;

Also, the bill entitled, An act to authorise and direct the commissioners of Cecil county, to levy a sum of money to pay for the building a bridge over the Big Elk river in the town of Elkton, and to raise the road at the south end

of said bridge, above tide water:
