Also, the bill entitled, An act to authorise the Levy court of Kent county, to levy a sum of money therein mentioned. to be applied to the enlargement and repair of the house in which the officers of clerk of the court and Register of Wills of said county, are kept and held; severally endorsed, "will pass;" ordered to be engrossed;

Also, the bill entitled, An act to provide for the cession of territorial jurisdiction at Turkey Point, in Cecil'county. for the erection of a Light house thereon by the Govern-

ment of the United States;

Also, the bill entitled, An act for the regulation and improvement of the village of Denton, in Caroline county, and for other purposes; severally endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendments;" which amendments were severally read the first and second time by special order; "assented to," and the bills ordered to be engrossed;

Also, the resolution in favour of the Rev Mr. Guest, and the Rev Mr. Blanchard, endorsed, 'assented to;" ordered

to be engrossed;

And, delivered a bill originated in and passed by the Senate, entitled, An act to define and enlarge the powers of courts of equity; which was read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice."

Also the bill, entitled, An act to exempt from taxation the buildings and ground of the Biltimore Athenaeum: which was read and referred to Messrs. Laurenson, Hunt

And delivered a communication from the executive: and Ely; "refered by the senate to the consideration of the house of delegates;" which was read and is as follows:

Executive Department, Annapolic, Feb. 27, 1832.

Gentlemen of the Senate, and of the House of Delegates,

I herewith lay before you, communications from the executives of the respective states of Massachusetts, Indiana and Tennessee, with resolutions of those respective states.
