And the bill reported by Mr. Kent, entitled, An act to prevent swine from going at large in the town of Pig Point in Anne Arundel county;

Were severally taken up for consideration, and referred to the consideration of the next general assembly.

Mr. Williamson submitted the following resolution:

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the Western Shore, be, and he is hereby authorised and directed, to pay to William M'Neir, Printer to the senate, the sum of one hundred and four dollars, for printing report, resolutions and appendix, relative to the southern and western limits of this state, out of any unappropriated money now in the treasury.*

Which was read the first and second time by special order, assented to and sent to the senate.

The bill from the senate, entitled, An act to restrain private banking;

Was taken up for consideration, read the second time and passed.

The bill from the senate, entitled, An additional supplement to the act entitled, An act directing the manner of suing out attachments in this province, and limiting the extent of them;

Was taken up for consideration, read the second time and rejected.

The bill reported by Mr. Hollman, entitled, An act to repeal the second supplement to the act entitled, An act to incorporate the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road company, passed at December session, 1826, chapter 123, and for other purposes therein mentioned;

Was taken up for consideration and read the second time;

On motion by Mr. Dalrymple,

Said bill was referred to the consideration of the next general assembly.

On motion by Mr. Hood,

The house took up for consideration the bill reported by him, entitled, An act to incorporate the Sam's Creek Rail Road company;

The said bill was then read the second time and passed.

Mr. Willson, from the committee on engrossed bills, delivered the following report.

The committee on engrossed bills, beg leave to report, that they have carefully examined and compared the en-
